

## Products requiring Certified Handler

Products with a hazard classification of Acute toxicity category 1 (HSNO 6.1A) or category 2 (HSNO 6.1B) must be under the control of a Certified Handler (or locked away securely). There are also thresholds above which a Location Compliance Certificate will need to be obtained.

This is **not** a definitive list – products change in formulation and new products enter the market. Some but not all of the key controls on the use of these products are noted - READ THE LABEL.

This list also excludes VTAs, post-harvest washing, soil fumigants and fumigants for other purposes such as storage. You are advised to check the labels or product safety information for all agrichemicals that you use.
